ReadMe File: Documentation for Population Reports on Task Force Website

This research note describes the racial and ethnic categories that are presented in the population reports, which accompany the individual district maps on the Task Force's website.

Two sets of racial and ethnic categories are displayed for each district: standard variables used by the Task Force in its work and supplemental variables specified by the federal Department of Justice (DOJ) to evaluate redistricting-plan compliance with the federal Voting Rights Act (VRA). The DOJ categories expand the definition of minority composition. Both sets of categories are derived from the Census Bureau's Public Law (PL) 94-171 redistricting dataset.

Part XX of the law directed the New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS) to provide the Task Force with information on incarcerated persons under its jurisdiction. The racial and ethnic categories accommodate missing responses that DOCCS collected from prisoners and supplied to the Task Force. (Complete documentation on the adjustment process can be found elsewhere on the Task Force's website.)

Ambiguous field names in the population reports are clarified below. The full field names were taken from the PL 94-171 technical documentation.

Population Report Field Names

NH = Non-Hispanic

Hwn = Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander

Multi = Multiracial

Other = Some Other Race

Unknown = Reflects instances where DOCCS did not provide racial and ethnic identification
